

Michael Thomas BARLOW

Dr. Barlow has an MA and D.Phil from the University of Oxford in Chemistry. He is also qualified as a UK and European Patent Attorney. Currently he is responsible for BP's patenting and IP licensing activities outside of the USA . He is President of the Trade Marks, Patents and Designs Federation (TMPDF – the principal Industry IP body in the UK) and chairman of the CEFIC IP Task Force. He is also a member of the UNICE IP Group, the Industry Trilateral and is a Council member of CIPA. Dr Barlow participated in the 2003 Royal Society study on the effect of IP on science and is a member of the UK Government's Community Patent and Litigation Focus Groups.
